Inclement Weather Policy/Loss of Power

Day Care:

New Day Children's Center will make every effort to remain open for service, even in times of inclement weather, for the convenience of the parents who rely on us so that they may meet work or school obligations. However, in the event that hazardous driving conditions exist in the county that causes the roads to be closed, travel prohibited, or a declaration of a state of emergency, New Day Children's Center will close. In the event that weather conditions develop as outlined above or if the center should lose power for more than 2 hours, either before or after the center has opened for operation, New Day will close. If we have already opened for business, we will begin the following process to notify our parents. We are currently using a voice texting service (Call Em All) that will allow us to notify you by phone. Teachers will also send out a group message on Dojo. If you are unable to have your phone at work, please make sure that we have an office or manager's number so that we can get a message to you. It is imperative that you keep your contact information current. We will do our best to give you at least a two hour notice. If the forecast calls for bad weather, and you have the availability of TV or radio at your place of employment, please listen for the possibility of an early closure.

New Day Children's Center Universal Pre-Kindergarten will follow the direction of the Watertown City School District. If there is a snow day, with no school, there is no Pre-K. If there is a 2 hours delay, Pre-K children will delay as well.
