UPCOMING PROJECTS THAT NEED TO BE DONE

Every year we have a need for a load of wood chips.

We order a half ton truck load and they are dropped at the Sterling Street entrance.

It requires 5 to 6 people with wheel barrels and shovels to help.

It takes an hour, or less, to get them loaded into the playground. It could be done afternoon or evening.

We need to put poles in the ground for a tarp to provide shade over the sandbox on the big playground. This would require securing four 4x4 poles in the sandbox and hanging the tarp.
